

The chic, modernist design and on-arrival Bellinis cast an immediate spell, and beautifully mannered, handsome Italian staff are the ultimate mood elevators.

The spa's miniature scale means that once you book a treatment, you pretty much have the whole space to yourself; the waiting room is like a private cabin to stretch out and unwind in. There are lots of grace notes — mani-pedis come with a herbal neck wrap, cue more complimentary Bellinis. Not that anyone walks in L.A., mind you, but the Travelers relief Massage is a great add-on treatment to redress our oft-neglected back, neck and twinkle toes — reflexology, scrubs and lymphatic massage are also brilliant for Aussies after that long flight. Try an aromatherapy steam and Keracell Facial and Body Wrap, which reinvigorates you from top to toe during hours of skin nourishing bliss, before that great local ritual: poolside loafing and star gazing (and outdoor rinema every Summer).

# VICEROY L'ERMITAGE

The private, peaceful setting of this low-rise gem on a tree-lined avenue creates a residential atmosphere - local directors and actors treat it as their own pied de terre, where they can hammer out many a movie deal. But inside the intimate rooftop spawith district views, only the birdsong filters through.

The massage program focuses on deep relaxation and detoxification including a Sports or Deep Tissue, while the more sensual, rejuvenating Ayurvedic Massage incorporates a Hair and Scalp conditioning that feels hypnotically languorous and leaves you zinging and tingling. The Superfruit Body Peel packs in the goodies, only this time the pomegranate, mandarin, goji and acai aren't in your breakfast bowl, but are used as exfoliating enzymes to buff and scrub skin to smoothness. They love the privacy off the street and great light."
