








#### **Waldorf Astoria Beverly Hills**

Splash out at the 12-storied, Hollywood's Golden Age glam- and art deco-inspired Waldorf Astoria Beverly Hills which already has patrons in raptures. Set in the very heart of Beverly Hills, richly elegant and unashamedly luxurious, this glamorous newbie (opened in June this year) on the block holds the promise of an exceptional experience. Its 170 guest rooms opening up on uninterrupted panoramas of its mind-boggling location, its Celebrity Villa Suites charged with

private patios and gardens, the swanky Jean-Georges restaurant, the 5,000 sq. ft decadent new La Prairie Spa, the largest rooftop pool deck in town, the humungous triple-height lobby which is the biggest in all of BH – all signal the arrival of a world that's a cut above the rest for high-flyers and the jet set, in all of sunny California.

The Beverly Hills Hotel & Bungalows

A century of glitterati have passed through the portals of this sumptuous hotel with its pink stucco facade and the landscaped grounds. Plunge joyfully into the rich atmospherics of this legend where the likes of Valentino and Liz Taylor have been residents. The hottest attraction here are the bungalows where Liz Taylor stayed for six of her eight honeymoons. You might even bump into Kim Kardashian, Michael Douglas, or Nicole Kidman. Save your greenbacks for a drink at the iconic Polo Lounge. The barman is a good source for yarns from the good ol' days. Power tables to be coveted are Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 'The Hollywood' for breakfast and Chopped McCarthy Salad for lunch or dinner, to blend in seamlessly. Trawl the grounds if you are a celeb-hunter...you might get lucky...



### Alo Yoga Boutique

Sixty-minute yoga classes are on offer through the week at the airy yoga studio and roof deck at Alo's Beverly Hills flagship store, where they arrive like lemmings accoutred in the iconic Alo Goddess leggings, crop tops and rolled-up yoga mat. A range of pressed juices and organic snacks are available at the cafe for pre/post-practice munchies. Danny Harris and Marco deGeorge started Alo in 2007, inspired by the concept of taking the consciousness from practice on the mat and putting it into practice in life - 'to spread good: to anyone who is experiencing the transformative power of yoga.'

- Head to Two Rodeo Beverly Hills Shopping Center for designer boutiques, exquisite restaurants and a village-like decor. Some of the world's top luxury brands including Versace, Jimmy Choo, Lanvin, and Tiffany & Co., have flagship stores at Two Rodeo.
- Beverly Center is one of the busiest shopping malls in tinsel town. The main stores (D&G Dolce & Gabbana, Dior, Just Cavalli, Louis Vuitton Bloomies, Macy's, Banana Republic, Coach, Victoria's Secret and the like) are located from the 5th floor upwards.





# Jean-Georges at Waldorf Astoria Beverly

The legendary French Chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten's first foray into the West Coast couldn't have had a better setting than the newly-opened Waldorf Astoria. Leaving behind a trail of iconic restaurants from Japan to London to New York City, Jean-Georges offers an opulent culinary experience richly worthy of LA's hip and happening patrons led by Hollywood celebs and gold-plated business magnets that rule the magic and clout of the City of Angels. The carefullycurated menu features the very best of his métier. Stop looking at your watch and wallet, dress up to the nines, pay the astronomical valet service and hit BH's sweet spot for the most memorable and pricey night on the tiles. The man himself, seen as one of the best living French chefs with multiple Michelin stars under his belt, ups the ante by working the floors meeting and greeting patrons at his three establishments in the hotel which include the smart casual Rooftop by JG, where one can dine in private cabanas, poolside and the Jean-Georges Beverly Hills Bar where patrons exchange gossip and cocktails by the hour.





#### **Spago Beverly Hills**

Go for the jaw-dropping locale, celebrity watching (read Justin Bieber, Julia Roberts and even former President Bill Clinton), the kingly service, outstanding food - do try the wiener schnitzel, the spicy ahi tuna hand rolls or the smoked salmon/caviar pizza - and the opulent atmospherics. All this and a lot more make this hugely expensive flagship restaurant (founded by glam, Austrian-born owner/chef Wolfgang Puck) a must-visit. Here the crowds from the motion pictures business rub shoulders with businessmen, amid the smattering of wealthy local patrons - all which remind you every dollar spent is worth it.

# Gratitude

This plant-based vegan restaurant opened end of May 2017 (and is sister restaurant to Café Gratitude, a more casual restaurant with many locations across Los Angeles). The menu is designed by Executive Chef Dreux Ellis and features a vegan twist on menu items such as mole enchiladas and pad thai!
